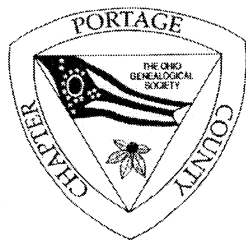

## Jan. 1941 34 Men In Ravenna District Selected For Army Training

Thirty-four young men from the Ravenna district have been selected by the selective service board No. 1 to be inducted into the nation's conscription army Jan. 28 at the Cleveland armory.

Names of the 28 selectees and six volunteers were announced today by G. W. Brooks, clerk of the Ravenna board.

Volunteers who will answer the Jan. 28 call are Alfred Purdy, Newton Falls; Angelo Anzelone, Ravenna; Albert Shay, Garrettsville; Willard Tice, Ravenna; Marshall Hall, Ravenna, and Joseph Tomsavosky, Garrettsville.

### Will Go to Cleveland

The 34 conscriptees will be transported from Ravenna to the Cleveland induction center by bus. The chartered bus will leave Ravenna at 8 a. m. Jan. 28.

Local selective service officials have not been notified regarding which camp the Portage selectees will serve following their induction into the army at Cleveland.

Notices to the 34 young men, the largest group yet inducted from Portage county, were mailed by Clerk Brooks Thursday, before Jan. 28, the selectees will receive a second notice ordering them to report for induction.

The Ravenna board will furnish seven men for the Feb. 10 call, according to a preliminary quota notice sent from Fort Hayes, Columbus. A large reserve of eligible men in class 1A, available for immediate military service, is being built up by the board. Thirty men have been ordered to report for physical examination Jan. 22 at Robinson Memorial hospital.



**PVT. ERNEST J. JAKAB**

Pvt. Ernest J. Jakab, son of Mr. and Mrs. B. A. Jakab of Windham has been in the army since Jan. 28, 1941. He is now stationed with Co. C, 131st. Q. M. Trk. Regiment, Base P. O., Camp Shelby, Miss.

He was employed on the railroad before his induction. During Easter week he enjoyed a furlough with his parents at Windham.

### Little Known Facts About The Tomb Of The Unknown Soldiers

On Jeopardy the other night, the final question was How many steps does the guard take during his walk across the tomb of the Unknown Soldier-- All three missed it --This is really an awesome sight to watch if you've never had the chance Very fascinating.

1. How many steps does the guard take during his walk across the tomb of the Unknowns and why?  
21 steps. It alludes to the twenty-one-gun salute, which is the highest honor given any military or foreign dignitary.
2. How long does he hesitate after his about face to begin his return walk and why?  
21 seconds for the same reason as answer number 1
3. Why are his gloves wet?  
His gloves are moistened to prevent his losing his grip on the rifle.
4. Does he carry his rifle on the same shoulder all the time and if not, why not?  
He carries the rifle on the shoulder away from the tomb.  
After his march across the path, he executes an about face and moves the rifle to the outside shoulder.
5. How often are the guards changed? Guards are changed every thirty minutes, twenty-four hours a day, 365 days a year.
6. What are the physical traits of the guard limited to?

For a person to apply for guard duty at the tomb he must be between 5' 10" and 6' 2" tall and his waist size cannot exceed 30." Other requirements of the Guard: They must commit 2 years of life to guard the tomb, live in a barracks under the tomb, and cannot drink any alcohol on or off duty for the rest of their lives. They cannot swear in public for the rest of their lives and cannot disgrace the uniform {fighting} or the tomb in any way. After two years, the guard is given a wreath pin that is worn on their lapel signifying they served as guard of the tomb. There are only 400 presently worn. The guard must obey these rules for the rest of their lives or give up the wreath pin.

The shoes are specially made with very thick soles to keep the heat and cold from their feet. There are metal heel plates that extend to the top of the shoe in order to make the loud click as they come to a halt. There are no wrinkles, folds or lint on the uniform. Guards dress for duty in front of a full-length mirror.

The first six months of duty a guard cannot talk to anyone, nor watch TV. All off duty time is spent studying the 175 notable people laid to rest in Arlington National Cemetery. A guard must memorize who they are and where they are interred. Among the notables are: President Taft, Joe E. Lewis (the boxer) and Medal of Honor winner Audie Murphy, (the most decorated soldier of WWII) of Hollywood fame. Every guard spends five hours a day getting his uniforms ready for guard duty.

In 2003 as Hurricane Isabelle was approaching Washington, DC, our US Senate/House took 2 days off with anticipation of the storm. On the ABC evening news, it was reported that because of the dangers from the hurricane, the military members assigned the duty of guarding the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier were given permission to suspend the assignment. They respectfully declined the offer, "No way, Sir!" Soaked to the skin, marching in the pelting rain of a tropical storm, they said that guarding the Tomb was not just an assignment, it was the highest honor that can be afforded to a serviceperson. The tomb has been patrolled continuously, 24/7, since 1930. God Bless and keep them.

**56 Leave Ravenna March 3 For Army; 20 Others Choose Navy**

Fifty-six of 80 Ravenna district selectees inducted into the army and navy in Cleveland this week will leave for the army Wednesday, March 3, from the Pennsylvania station in Ravenna.

Twenty of the 80 men passing their physical examinations selected the navy and will leave for active service on an unannounced date. Four of the 60 men approved for the army refused their furloughs and proceeded directly to the reception center.

**13 ARE REJECTED**

Thirteen men were rejected for physical disability and four failed to report for examination.

The army inductees are ordered to report Wednesday at 11 a.m. at the selective service board headquarters in Riddle block No. 1. They will leave for Camp Perry from the Pennsylvania station at 11:55 a.m.

Fifty-seven of 96 selectees sent by the Ravenna selective service board to Akron for physical examinations Saturday passed examinations and will report for active duty No. 7.

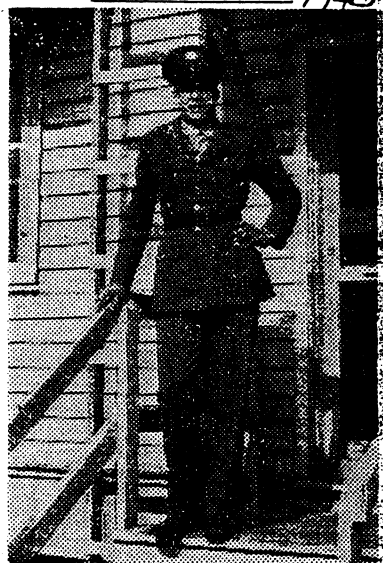

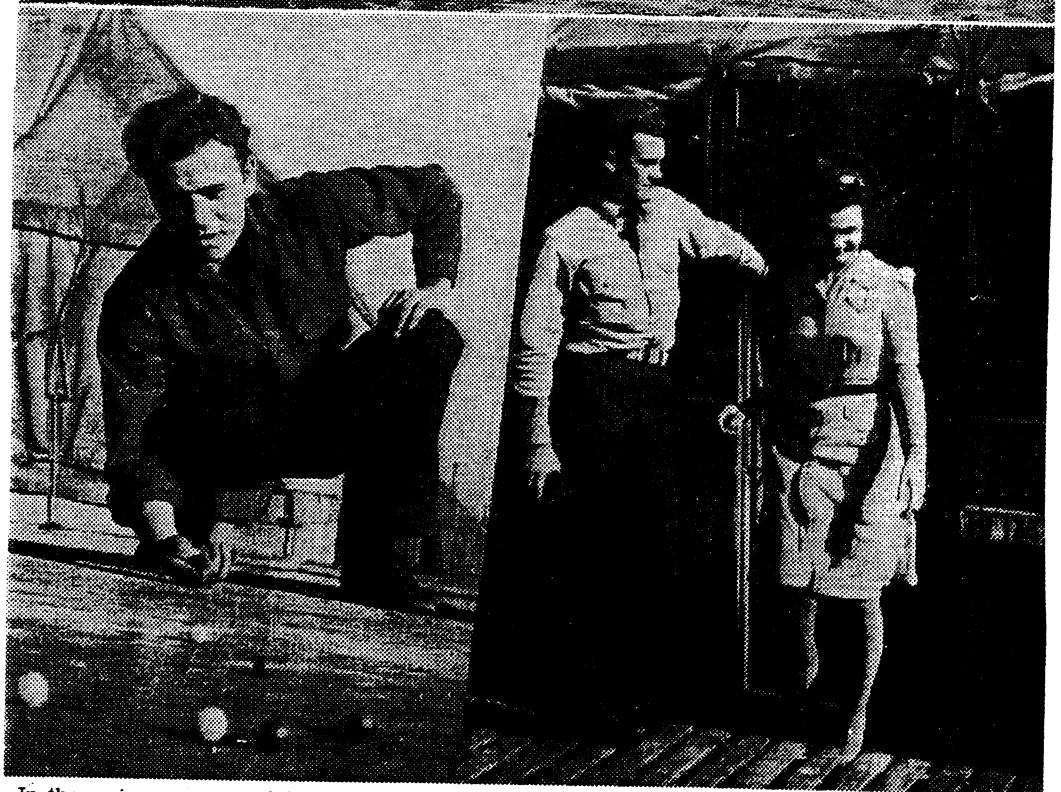
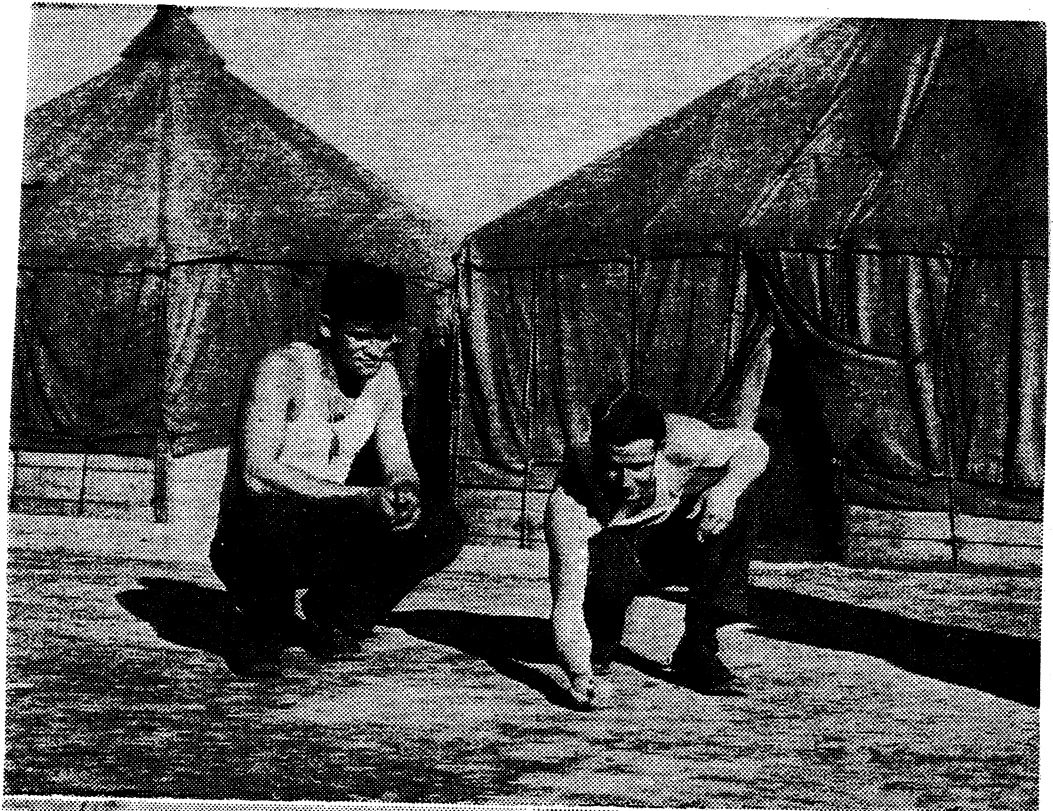
